

BOOK CLUB NOVEL REFLECTIONS

Directions: On a separate piece of paper, write or type your responses to the following questions or prompts. Take your time to develop thoughtful and specific answers that demonstrate that you read your book club novel with care.

1. What was the title of the Book Club novel you read?
2. Describe the plot (sequence of events) of the book in five sentences or less.
3. What would you consider the most significant event in the novel and why? You need not choose the climax (or high point) of the plot, but rather the event that you believe had the most impact on the overall story.
4. What is your opinion of the book? Did you like it or not? Explain why you feel the way you do. Refer to the plot, characters and writing style; be as specific as possible.
5. Who is your favorite character in the book and why?
6. If you met this character, what would you ask (or tell) him or her?
7. Think of one way that a person in the book solved a problem. Describe the problem and how this character responded. What did you learn from this character that you could use in solving a problem of your own.
8. Think of a situation other than the problem you describe in #7 above. Describe the situation and how the character responded. What would you have done in a similar situation? Would you have acted the same or differently?
9. If you had to come up with another title for this book, what would it be and why?
10. What type of person/reader would like this book best? Explain.
